

However, many are calling for changes that move in the same direction as the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) denomination. The Disciples left the teachings of the Bible and headed down the road of liberalism 100 years ago. They accepted theistic evolution, hierarchical organization, women elders and preachers, and practice open fellowship. They affirm ... ordination of homosexuals (66 percent of the conventional vote) and that Hindus, Moslems and other religions can be saved without faith and obedience to Christ (See the documents from their annual meetings for 1989, 1990, 1992, 1993).

Those in the church who are calling for the changes in the church today to adopt the same errors that the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) adopted must be challenged and refuted (Titus 1:9-11). If they want to practice such errors, let them go to the Disciples. Members of the church of Christ must purify themselves in order to please God and save souls.
